

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Thanks to a generous donation from the Robert and Helen E. Grant Foundation, the San Diego Natural History Museum (The Nat) is pleased to offer summer camp scholarships for Summer 2026.

Partial funding is available to families who would otherwise not be able to participate in our program. There is a \$25 administrative fee required. Transportation to and from The Nat for your camper is required, as are completed camper release forms.

Scholarships are available for children in grades 1-8. All classes are taught in English; English learners are welcome.

In order to be considered for a scholarship, applicants must complete a Scholarship Application Form. If the form is not complete, the applicant will not be considered. **We will begin accepting applications on Tuesday, February 17.** We encourage families to send their application in as soon as possible. Once all available scholarships are awarded, new applicants will be placed on a waitlist. Submission of an application does not guarantee receipt of a scholarship or attendance at a particular camp.

Families will be notified whether or not they have received a scholarship within three weeks of submission of an application. Campers will also receive a snack and lunch for each day of camp and a camp T-shirt.


